- Budget spreadsheet review

    - Move to high school budget line

  - Transportation will not need all money, will need \$2500
    - Lowered mileage rate on negotiations this year
  - Stage equipment have \$500 left to spend
  - Spirit wear no further expenses, will have \$\$ coming in
  - Southview Have \$886 remaining, don't think they will spend it all
    - Will pay \$184 for pizza
  - o Parkview still have SCICDA dinner
  - Julefest spent <\$500</li>

- Spirit wear
  - Reports from Raygun will get \$3000
  - One more push on social media "time is running out"
- Fundraising
  - Raised \$26k YTD
    - Over halfway toward our goal, but slowing down
  - Market
    - See full report issues with tip jar, competing with market for tips, and lack of getting the credit card receipts (go to market)
    - May go cashless next year, may be able to log into square to get tips or divide credit card tips equally
    - Has future potential
      - Other than beverage certification, just need to show up
      - No cost, no planning work
  - February change challenge
  - March 4th spring raffle kickoff
    - Broadway vs Nashville?
      - Social media vote with options
    - Will try to get feedback from last year's winner
  - Candy bouquets, flowers and shout outs at spring show
    - Can sell 4x as many this year!
    - Need candy bouquet committee
    - Presale shout outs that are projected before show instead
  - State large group concessions
  - Projected spring revenue ~\$11,800
    - \$13,000 shortfall of goal
      - \$50k was somewhat arbitrary
    - Do we need to consider a summer fundraiser?
      - Reassess after spring show
